The data behind Bismarck-Mandan's most pressing issues

Education

- More than 35% of low-income students in Bismarck and Mandan are not meeting third grade reading proficiency levels. Research indicates that failure to reach this benchmark makes children four times less likely to graduate from high school on time.
- Economically challenged students in North Dakota are 22% less likely to graduate from high school.
- Only 29% of youth in Bismarck-Mandan feel they have a positive adult role model.

Income

- In 2013, homelessness was down 40% in North Dakota, yet over 8.4% of people in Burleigh County and 14% of children in our region are living in poverty.
- This past school year, 528 students in Bismarck and Mandan Public Schools were identified as homeless, often sleeping in cars, tents or shuffling from couch to couch.

Health

- Sixty-six percent of adults in North Dakota are overweight.
- One of five children in Bismarck-Mandan is receiving SNAP benefits.
- By 2025, individuals 60+ are projected to grow to nearly 30% of North Dakota's population.
